Flu vax now available

The 2015 influenza vaccine is now available. This is the NEW triple strain vaccine. NSW Health provides this vaccine free of charge to those who qualify (patients over 65 years of age, with chronic diseases, expecting mothers etc). Your doctor will advise you if you qualify for a Gov't funded vaccine—please enquire at your next consultation. Otherwise flu vax is available for \$20.

There is also a four strain influenza vaccine—it is available from any chemist on prescription.

NSW Health advises that this year's flu season may be more severe than usual. If you haven't had your flu vax shot yet please see your GP or our nurse Sophia.

Booking appointments

Dr Nindhi Ahilan is on maternity leave and some of our GPs will be taking leave over the winter season as well.

If you experience difficulties in booking appointments with your treating GP please try to see any available GP on the day. We endeavor to meet the needs of all our patients.

When you need to see a GP urgently on the day please mention that to our receptionist. Our receptionists are trained in triaging patients. They will always try to help you out. You can always talk with our nurse if you need advice or reassurance.

It is our policy to fit in sick children and patients with emergencies on the day. This means that patients with appointments may have to wait longer than expected.

If you can't get in to see a GP on the day please try our after hours doctors. Home Doctors (13 74 25) and Sydney Medical Service (8724 6300) provide bulk billed home visits from 4pm to 8am the following morning, weekends from 11am on Saturday and throughout public holidays.

In an emergency always call 000 and ask for an ambulance or go to an emergency at a hospital near you.

What did Federal Budget 2015 bring to health?

In the May Federal Budget there were some interesting changes. Some of the new measures include:

New immunisation programs:

Starting from 1 November 2016, a shingles vaccination program for patients aged 70, with catch-up program for 71-79 yr olds to follow

An additional DiphtheriaPertussisTetanus (DTP) vaccination at age 18 months from 1 January 2016.

Adult vaccination register from 1 September 2016.

Things taken away:

The 4 yr old Health Assessments cancelled from 1 July 2015

Pap test program changes to 5 yearly HPV tests covering ages 25-74 from 1 May 2017

Acupuncture relieves hay fever

Australian researchers in Melbourne conducted a rendomised study looking at effects of acupuncture (12 sessions over 4 weeks) on seasonal allergic rhinitis. They found that sneezing and itchiness of ears and palate were significantly less, even after 4 weeks after the therapy had finished.
